DeCoil™ Shock Pack Updates and Improvements

Werner Fall Protection is excited to announce the continuous improvement of our product line within the Energy Absorbing Lanyard platform with a new and improved protective shock pack cover for all DeCoil Energy Absorbing Lanyards. As part of a rolling change, all new shock packs will incorporate a polyester cover replacing the PVC shrink tube, and change from a blue back-up strap to an undyed white back-up strap.

This new durable cover will be sewn around the tear web and secured at each end. This results in better resistance to the elements and outside contaminants, while providing a softer and more ergonomic feel to the user. The new protective cover also includes better integration of the product labels. The label cover is wrapped around the pack and held in place with a black elastic and fastened with hook and loop, delivering better protection from UV degradation.

No change has been made to the performance or the energy absorbing properties of the DeCoil shock packs.

All pricing and part #'s will remain unchanged. Production of this DeCoil improvement will begin on July 13 and shipments of all affected lanyards will transition to this new style over the coming months.

Our willingness to work towards continuous improvement demonstrates commitment to our high product quality and our customers, while addressing evolving industry standards and regulatory requirements.
